Use of AI tools in the review process

The Research School has guidelines on the use of AI tools in the application and review process for its funding programmes. These guidelines contain the following information for reviewers and for the decision-making process:

1. The use of AI tools by applicants in the preparation of applications is not an evaluation criterion and is not taken into account in the review process.
2. The use of AI is not permitted for the review process.

(1) How comprehensible was the doctoral project's general description in the application?

[Has the applicant made the relevance of his/her research clear to you? Has the applicant used unclear subject-specific terms and abbreviations unnecessarily frequently for you?]

(2) Do you understand the motivation of the applicant to participate in this specific event?

[Has the applicant's contribution to the conference been made clear? Was the applicant able to clarify what his/her contribution to the research discourse is?]

(3) How do you assess the impact of the conference participation on the quality of the whole PhD project?

[Has the applicant been able to explain why he/she wants to attend this specific conference? Is it clear which researchers the applicant would like to meet at the conference and why he/she would like to discuss his/her research with them? Does it become clear what the applicant wants to take away from the conference?]

(4) What is your assessment of the conference participation's potential impact on the research career and the international network of the applicant?

[Will new contacts be created or existing contacts strengthened? Will the applicant benefit from these contacts in the future? What does participation in the conference mean for the visibility of the applicant and his/her in the research field?]
